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2. OBJECTIVE OF THE REQUEST

APLA's background:

The Association of Palestinian Local Authorities (APLA) founded in 1997, APLA is an independent organization mandated to represent and lobby for the collective interests of Local Government Units (LGUs) by supporting capacity building among local governments, facilitating exchange of knowledge and best practices, and serving as vehicle for dialogue between the central government and LGUs. APLA is a semi-governmental nonprofit association that forms a comprehensive framework, which holds all the Palestinian local authorities and works for and with them, to provide better services for the Palestinian citizen by defending their rights, and representing them on all levels nationally, regionally, and internationally.

Project Brief:

The United Nations Development Programme (UNDP) implements the programme of "Transparency, Evidence, Efficiency, Effectiveness and Accountability TEA3", and as a part of this programme, UNDP signed a grant agreement with APLA to execute the project of "Enhancing Accountability and Transparency of Palestinian Local Government Units (LGUs) through Public hearing, Baladia IT meter, and Mayor's forum to address the future of the local government in Palestine".

The Main Objective is:

Services of an Expert to Conduct an Assessment for the Current Status of Local Government Sector and Develop Future Vision of Local Government Sector in Palestine through Mayor's Forum.

The Specific Objectives are:

- Conduct a revision and assessment for the (legislative, financial, administrative...) of local government sector in Palestine.
- Lead discussions and facilitate sessions and/or meetings for LGUs mayors through the Mayors' Forum to collect feedbacks.
- Organizing several high-level meetings with the key stakeholders on the local government sector such as MoLG, MDLF, MoF, and other stakeholders.
- Prepare analysis and assessment report including challenges, obstacles, weaknesses, opportunities, etc... for the current situation of local government sector.



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- Based on the consultations and the feedback, develop a comprehensive vision for the future system of local government sector in Palestine.
- Define the requirements to achieve the proposed future vision.

- Experience in implementing and leading of official meetings, sessions, seminars, conferences, workshops including material preparation.
- 7. Strong analytical, communication, and management skills.
- 8. Excellent writing, reporting, and time management skills.
